


## **Best Practice: Decontamination of Family Liaison iPad / Smartphone**



**Decontamination of iPad / Smartphone** 

Wear appropriate PPE e.g. disposable, non-sterile gloves and apron



- Using a 70% isopropyl alcohol wipe or Clorox Disinfecting Wipes, gently wipe the hard, non-porous surfaces of the iPad/Smartphone, such as the display and other exterior surfaces. Do not use bleach. Avoid getting moisture in any opening, and do not submerge the iPad/Smartphone in any cleaning agents.
- Thoroughly dry.

- Immediately decontaminate
  the iPad/Smartphone with
  disposable cloths/paper roll
  and fresh solution of
  detergent, rinse, dry and
  follow with a disinfectant
  solution of 1,000 parts per
  million available chlorine,
  rinse and thoroughly dry
- Avoid getting moisture in any opening, and do not submerge the iPad/Smartphone in any cleaning agents.
- Immediately decontaminate
   the iPad/Smartphone with
   disposable cloths/paper roll
   and fresh solution of
   detergent, rinse, dry and follow
   with a disinfectant solution of
   1,000 parts per million
   available chlorine, rinse and
   thoroughly dry
- Avoid getting moisture in any opening, and do not submerge the iPad/Smartphone in any cleaning agents
- Discard disposable cloths/paper roll immediately into the clinical waste stream
- Discard detergent/disinfectant solution in the designated area
- Clean, dry and store re-usable decontamination equipment
- Remove and discard PPE
- Perform hand hygiene
