- Project group made up of a wide range of professionals
- Currently 3 groups set up wider activities to be started when restrictions allow (cooking, walking group, Technogym)
- Keeping in touch with core group via Teams
- Regular contact with wider group through email and phone calls


Healthy & Connected Communities

- EU funded 5 year project; 2017 to 2021*
- Supporting older people (65+) living with long-term conditions
- Enabling people to live well, safely and independently in their own homes
- Supporting self-management of their care in their community



Importance of Self-management





- Long term conditions require ongoing management and become more prevalent with age:
 - Aged 65-74s 65%
 - over 75s 72%
- LTCs account for large proportion of GP appointments and hospital admissions
- Helping people live in better health for longer
- Self Management is managing for yourself, not by yourself (Alliance)



Community Navigators support beneficiaries to develop person centred, holistic, Wellbeing Plans and Anticipatory Care Plans. This includes:

- Self Management
- Independent living
- Digital health interventions
- Social prescribing


